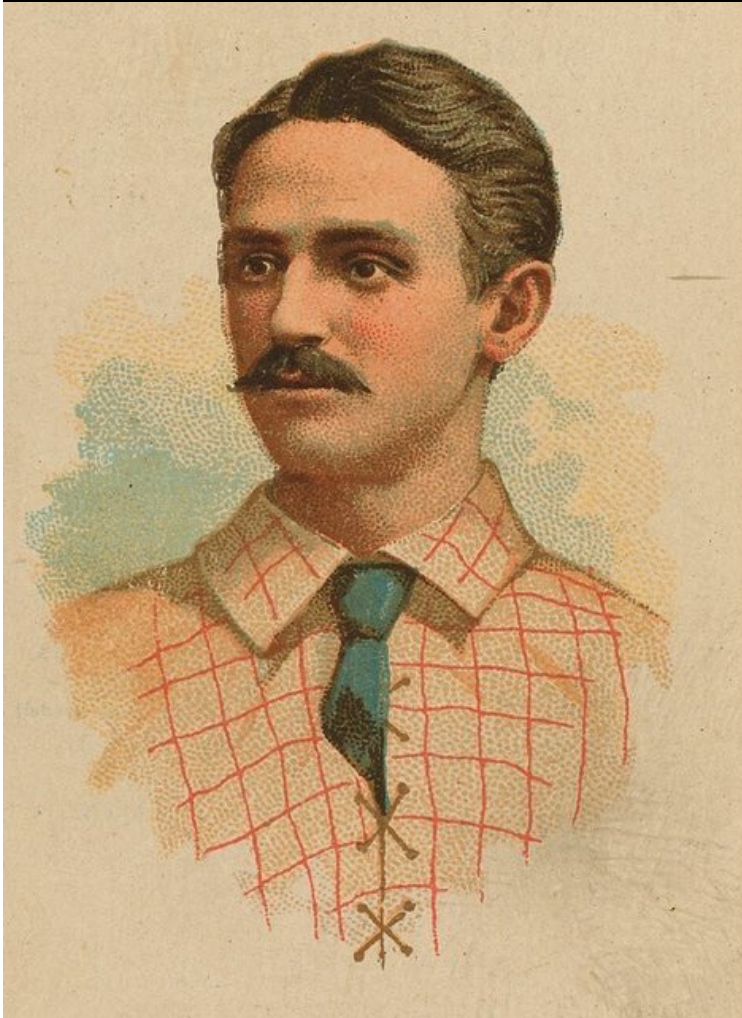
Update on Rockford's Beyer Stadium, Home to the Rockford Peaches
